We ourselves have experienced this when we called the Police to our property when a person was hiding in the scrub at the bottom of our driveway. It took Police 5 hours to attend, my wife and son were at home alone.

We are also concerned that the increased traffic through the area of associates of participants allows or may contribute to an increase in crime.

As there are many young families in our area, who move here for a quieter life and a more wholesome upbringing for their children, we believe that moving serious recidivist offenders to an unsecure facility will discourage people from bringing their families here, changing the demographic of a close knit community, potentially reducing school roles which is already a problem for many rural schools.
