There has already been A rehab house for young boys near this and it caused a lot of problems for nearby neighbours eventually closing and moving nearer town.

People have a right to feel safe in their neighbourhood.

Surely this would be far better nearer town with all the help needed right there. Not out in our quiet rural community.
