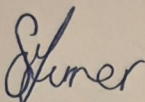

- 1) Rural are for this programme is the wrong location as all emergency Services are to far away for a facility like this.
- 2) With the emergency Services so far away it does not make this community feel safe with the proposed facility
- 3) There is very limited phone coverage throughout waikite valley
- 4) The location is in a rural area and the proposed activity is not rural or lifestyle in terms of it's characteristics
- 5) increase of traffic in a rural zone where farm animals are often on roads moving to different farms
- 6) my family moved rural to enjoy the lifestyle and the safety being in a rural community - this proposed facility will not make my family feel safe
- 7) i want to raise my son being rural and lifestyle to have the freedom around the farm - having this proposed facility here will mean more traffic through waikite valley and on our road as its one of the main roads to the proposed facility
- 8) waikite valley school and daycare are not far from this location which makes it unsafe.
- 9) i will not feel safe sending my son to school when he starts as it is to close to this proposed facility
