Certain fire designs must be sent to FEINZ for review under section 46 of the Building Act. In order to make a decision as to which applications must be sent the following test must be met!

Applications fall into one of the following categories:

Clause 1- Fire and Emergency New Zealand Act 2017 <u>sections 76 to 79</u>, relevant building means a building or part of a building used for 1 or more of the following purposes:

Section 75 - 1 (a) NZFSA			
(i)	The gathering together, for any purpose, of 100 or more persons:		
(ii)	Providing employment facilities for 10 or more persons:		
(iii)	Providing accommodation for more than 6 persons (other than in 3 or fewer household units):

Section 75 - 2 NZFSA
