Notes on Overall

Condition:

Modified semi-coastal forest, previously logged, isolated by clearance of

surrounding land and its conversion to pasture.

Change Relative to Shaw and Beadel

(1998):

Unknown - probably little change.

Threats/Modification/

Vulnerability:

This site is currently heavily grazed by cattle (Shaw and Beadel 1998).

Risk Assessment: Grazing (cattle): Risk to site - high; Timeframe - high.

Significance Level: Local (Appendix 4 - Table 1 - Criteria 1, 9; Table 2 - Factor L1).

Significance This site is of local significance as it is a good quality example of a semi-Justification: coastal forest which is under-represented in the existing reserve system in

the Otanewainuku ED.

Fieldwork Required: No fieldwork required to assess significance, but fieldwork is required to

update biodiversity and management information.

Notes: Small semi-coastal forest remnant. Semi-coastal vegetation is under-

represented in the existing reserve system.
