Indigenous Flora: No threatened or at risk species, as listed in de Lange *et al.* (2009), have been recorded from this site.

Fauna: No threatened or at risk species, as listed in Hitchmough *et al.* (2007) or Miskelly *et al.* (2008), have been recorded from this site.

Notes on Overall Condition: Heavily modified indigenous forest.

Change Relative to Shaw and Beadel (1998): Unknown - probably little change.

Threats/Modification/Vulnerability: Heavily modified by past logging disturbance.

Risk Assessment: Unknown.

Significance Level: Local (Appendix 4 - Table 1 - Criteria 1, 9; Table 2 - Factor L1).

Significance Justification: This site is of local significance as it is a good quality example of semi-coastal forest which is under-represented in the existing reserve system of the Otanewainuku ED.

Fieldwork Required: No fieldwork required to assess significance, but fieldwork required to update biodiversity and management information.

Notes: Though highly modified, this area is a relatively large example of indigenous forest. Semi-coastal vegetation is under-represented in the existing reserve system in the Otanewainuku ED.
