**Indigenous Flora:** No threatened or at risk species, as listed in de Lange *et al.* (2009), have been recorded from this site. Kohekohe is present.

**Fauna:** No threatened or at risk species, as listed in Hitchmough *et al.* (2007) or Miskelly *et al.* (2008), have been recorded from this site. Common forest bird species present.

**Notes on Overall Condition:** Tall forest modified by logging for podocarps. Small area isolated by clearance of surrounding land.

**Change Relative to Shaw and Beadel (1998):** Unknown - probably little change.

**Threats/Modification/Vulnerability:** This area was grazed in 1996.

**Risk Assessment:** Grazing: Risk to site - medium; Timeframe - medium.

**Significance Level:** Local (Appendix 4 - Table 1 - Criteria 1, 9; Table 2 - Factor L1).

**Significance Justification:** This site is of local significance because, although relatively small, it contains an example of tall indigenous forest.

**Fieldwork Required:** No fieldwork required to assess significance, but fieldwork required to update biodiversity and management information.

**Notes:** This area was recommended for protection in Beadel *et al.* (1998). Removal of grazing animals would enhance ecological values.
